Terms of Payment

- Families may elect to pay monthly for 10 months, beginning before the first month of school.
- Students may not attend classes until the initial tuition is paid. All subsequent monthly payments are due by the 10th of each month.
- If an account becomes 30 days past due, the student will not be allowed to return to school until the account has been made current or arrangements have been made/approved through the school administration. Consistent failure to meet the financial obligations of the chosen payment plan may result in dismissal of the student.
- New students entering during the school year shall pay at the time of enrollment for the entire month in which they are enrolled and monthly thereafter.
- A \$30 charge will be assessed for NSF payments (returned checks).

Past Due Tuition

- *Transferring Students*– BCA does not release transcripts for transfer until all fees are paid in full.
- *Continuing Students* – Report cards will not be given to student(s) with delinquent accounts. All past due fees must be paid in full by the end of the school year to eliminate the possibility of future enrollment being terminated.
- *Graduating Students*– Seniors will not receive a diploma nor will transcripts be released to colleges until all fees are paid in full.
